

Proper labelling of tubes

- Inappropriately-labelled blood tubes increases difficulty during sample processing and test analysis.
- Key points in labelling of tubes:
 - > Place the label straight along the length of the tube (ensures that barcode can be scanned).
 - > Leave a "window" to allow laboratory staff to check sample volume and quality.
 - > Do not leave little bumps in the label as this will affect the scanning of the barcodes.
